Discipleship@Galilee — Deepening the Walk



This past quarter, our Discipleship@Galilee gatherings have continued to anchor us in the essentials of the Christian life:

- Grounded in His Word
- Rooted in Prayer
- Faithful in Witness
- Yielded in Heart Surrender

Rather than striving for outward growth alone, we sensed a collective prompting to strengthen inward foundations—to build lives that endure, especially in seasons of uncertainty.

Living the Word — Devotions Shaped Life

Discipleship@Galilee Retreat 2026 — La Tierra, Chiang Mai

Rooted in Christ. Rested in His Presence. Ready to Bear Testimony.



This March, our Galilee family gathered in Chiang Mai for a 4-day retreat at La Tierra—a time set apart to pause, seek the Lord, and realign our hearts.

A Journey of Rest, Reflection & Renewal

Day 1–2 — Returning to What Matters

Day 1 saw us eased into the retreat with fellowship, unhurried conversations, and shared meals. Day 2 centred on Whole-Life Discipleship—a timely reminder that:

- Discipleship is daily, not occasional (Luke 9:23)
- Jesus is Lord of all, not just parts
- We are called to keep our
 - Compass in the world
 - Focus on God
 - Mission in His Word

Through honest sharing and reflection, many were stirred to:

- Walk more intentionally with God daily
- Embrace their current season with faith
- Surrender their “inner script” to Him

Day 3 — Joy in Creation & Community

A day of exploration and rest—nature walks, waterfalls, bamboo rafting, and more.

Beyond the activities, we experienced: God meeting us not just in sessions, but in creation, conversations, and companionship.

Even simple moments—like helping one another across a bamboo bridge—became living pictures of:

Walking together and finishing well together

Day 4 — Seeing God’s Work

Our visit to Grace International School was deeply inspiring.

We witnessed:

- Christ-centred education lived out with excellence
- A clear vision faithfully executed over time

It reminded us:

To build well, not just fast

To trust God’s timing in our own journey

Redeeming the Time #1 — When God Leads Us to Pause

Bavet Preschool Initiative — A Season of Recalibration

This past quarter, the Bavet Preschool initiative entered a meaningful season of pause and realignment.

While earlier efforts focused on launching the school, we sensed the Lord leading us instead to strengthen the foundations—particularly in building a sustainable teacher pipeline and deeper local partnerships.

On the Ground

Through Pastor Chanthorn, who has been faithfully engaging churches across Svay Rieng, a pastors’ gathering was organised on 8 April, bringing together leaders to share the vision of Christ-centred education and explore potential teacher recruitment.

Despite ongoing challenges—such as relocation concerns and limited trained educators—we are encouraged by individuals stepping forward in faith, even committing themselves to training and service.

A Shift in Focus

In prayer and discernment, we aligned on this approach for the current season:

- Strengthening the teacher pipeline
- Deepening church engagement
- Continuing training and preparation

Rather than rushing ahead, we choose to build well and steward faithfully.

Looking Ahead

We continue to commit this work into the Lord’s hands—trusting that He is preparing hearts, raising leaders, and establishing the right foundations in His perfect timing.
